Fernand Carette (Marcinelle, 1921 - 2005).

Painter, designer, gouache painter. Training at the Academy of Charleroi (1935-1946).

Between 1940 and 1948, he sought his own style and aesthetics.

First exhibition at the Galerie "Le Parc" in Charleroi in 1949.

He works both in a figurative and abstract style but most often opts for lyrical abstraction, through which he can express his personality without having to disguise his fight, his sorrow, his despair, his disgust.

Around 1965, he got closer and closer to surrealism and worked with the "Phases" group.
