BOCH La Louvière. Created in 1841, at La Louvière in Belgium, by Eugène and Victor, the Kéramis factory is a great classic pottery, whose flagship is the realization of decorations of Delft. The arrival in 1906 of designer Charles Catteau gave it new impetus. Present at the International Exhibition of Decorative Arts in 1925 and the Salon d'Automne in Paris, she worked for the art workshops of department stores - Primavera, Pomone and la
