Description

Very beautiful drawing representing riders in motion. Ink on paper, with artist's annotations. In its presentation case, very well preserved. Signature and stamp. Dated 1913. Georges Préveraud de Sonneville (1889-1979) was a painter, draftsman and engraver from Bordeaux. Upon his arrival in Bordeaux in 1903, he took painting lessons with the symbolist painter Paul Antin. He then attended the Rosa Bonheur Academy. He left for Paris in 1913, where he met the nabbis at the Académie Ranson - Paul Sérusier, Maurice Denis. He alternated moments of life between Paris and Bordeaux, which made him a representative of modernism in Bordeaux, in the wake of painters such as André Lhote, whom he frequented from the 1910s. He co-founded in 1928 with Jean- Loup Simian the
