Pair of revisited Empire style armchairs, designed with a mahogany frame covered with snakeskin imitation crocodile leather. The armrests are in the form of sculpted outstretched wings, extended by eagle-legged legs whose claws grip balls. The entire seat is a contemporary interpretation of the Empire style in the spirit of Napoleon's cabinetmaker Jacob. We thus find in the composition of the seat the mahogany wood specific to the Empire, the imperial eagle and in memory of the Egyptian campaign the Nile crocodile.
