Son of a horsewoman, he spent his early
childhood in the magic of the circus and behind
the scenes of the Music Hall.

Very early on, he revealed a talented and original
personality.

He began his artistic career in 1936, making short
animated films. Versatile artist, Norbert will be in
turn: pianist, renowned mime, unusual filmmaker,
author, painter, draftsman flirting between
expressionism and surrealism, he was called the
"naïve black".

He had always painted, but it was only in the
