After his primary studies, he returned to the customs service in Matadi. In 1945 following a meeting with a European painter, he followed his vocation. His natural gifts quickly made up for the shortcomings of his training. In 1958, he participated in the Universal Exhibition in Brussels with a shipment. In 1966, his works were presented at the first "World Festival of Negro Arts in Dakar". In 1970, he took part in the Exhibition of Zairian Art in Brussels. He organizes a few other individual exhibitions in the country, notably at the Academy of Fine Arts in Kinshasa on the
