



## Poro Statue - Senoufo From Ivory Coast

### Description

Very large and rare statue of Guard of the PORO society of the Senoufo of the region of Khorogo, in the north-east of the Ivory Coast, of Ivory Coast  
Height 165cm Wood very eroded by its seniority and lacks Standing man masked at the legs strongly elongated Two swords in relief represented on either side of each leg The character holding a kind of scepter in his right arm and the other folded all along his torso The face covered with a stylized hood, a flat mouth and two large nails forming the eyes wood patinated black accident at the end of the feet, a part missing on one and the other detached (to be glued) Look carefully at the photos and ask me for others if necessary We can find this very rare type of fairly identical sculpture in three reference works; The first is "Africana" by Arnold Bamert
