After the model of Paul Louis Cyfflé (1724-1806) A milkmaid, a seller of scapulars and a newspaper seller. Subjects representing the popular classes appreciated by lovers of the bourgeois and aristocratic classes of the late 18th century.

Marked Niderviller on the back and interlaced C at the tip under the base.

Paul-Louis Cyfflé sculptor and ceramist, founded the Lunéville factory, he acquired a reputation in the world of ceramics his name is associated with the Land of Lorraine Molds probably taken over by the Niderviller factory after the bankruptcy of the Cyfflé factory in Lunéville in 1779.
