Description

Lovely Semainier in the Louis XV style, whose top consists of a beautiful Aleppo marble in beige tones matching the shape of the piece of furniture, embellished with a bec-de-corbin molding. This piece of furniture is composed of 7 drawers of the same height with a curved front, in Amaranth veneer decorated with floral motifs in marquetry, and in oak for their bottoms and sides. They are each furnished with bronze pull handles, and a keyhole of the same alloy: this one, original like the key that accompanies it, is in working order. This property rests on quarter-round legs veneered in horizontal amaranth, ending in a Louis XV "bump" leg with a bronze sabot. This base stands out harmoniously with the low crosspiece on the front, nicely scalloped and decorated in its potbellied part with a bronze
