Description

Table in cherry wood of Helvetic origin approaching the tables of money changers from the early 19th century Pretty table that can be dismantled because the top is held by 4 side pegs typical of high mountain tables: Haute-Savoie or Switzerland The belt has 2 drawers on the front: 1 large and 1 small which is very rare The 4 legs are turned, 1 rear leg slightly tucked in Crosspieces cut on the sides Beautiful blond cherry wood Some usual restorations: 1 ink stain on an angle which is normal for its age Large overhang of the top around the perimeter Table that can very well be used as a desk long: 121.6 cm width: 74.6 cm h: 76 cm
