Ghom carpet in hand-knotted wool, measuring 192 cm wide by 304 cm long, Iran around 1980 in very good condition.

The beginning of the manufacture of Ghom or Ghom carpets is set up in this city around 1920/1930 on the initiative and thanks to the perseverance of the knotters and merchants of Kashan.

The manufacture of these beautiful, very resistant rugs is certainly recent, but the skilful and precise knotters as well as the "Ostads" cartoonists have imposed their know-how thanks to the perfection of their work and the amplitude of the range of designs and colors. colors.

Second holy city of Iran, 150 km from Tehran, Ghom is a major theological center.

The knot used is the very tightly tied Persian

Marketing is done under several names: Qom, Ghom, Gom, Qum, Kum, and Ghoum.

The Ghoum have a very colorful appearance, often with a white or ivory background that highlights the patterns, which is not the case with our model. Characteristic of the Persians, the boteh, an almond-shaped design and in some cases cypresses adorn these very beautiful carpets.

Our model decorated with a medallion and plants is in very good condition in a classic spirit and has very pleasant colors such as vermillion red and mustard.
