From left to right; 1/ Commemorative medal of the Verdun medal. 2/ Croix de guerre 14-18 with a bronze star, original ribbon. 3/ Commemorative medal of the department of Calvados for the 50th anniversary of the armistice of November 11, 1918. 4/ Commemorative medal of the 60th anniversary of November 11, 1918. 5/ Legion of honor of the 3rd republic. 6/ Military Medal. The decorations surround a photograph of the uniformed air vessel from 1914.
