




## Raymond Dierickx : "the Procession/study For The Flight Into Egypt"



## Description

Raymond Dierickx (1904-1978): "The procession/Study for The Flight into Egypt" mixed technique double-sided on paper 80 X 81 cm presented under neutral pH mat 100 X 100 cm. The procession travels through the city between the stepped buildings, passing from the sun to the shade. Verso: a man carrying a bundle passes in front of a mother holding her child. It was a real discovery for us that this beautiful Belgian artist! Even found in sheets and dusted with dust, these drawings, once prepared and framed, reveal all the talent of Dierickx, close to artists such as Nicolas Eeckmann, Fritz Van den Berghe, Constant Permeke or other typically Flemish expressionists such as Anto Carte, representing Fêtes, processions, fairs in the great tradition of Flemish painters dating back to the
