ICART (Louis). [Signed etching and aquatint]: "Dalila". Dimensions (at sight): 566 x 368 mm. Presented in mat and black lacquered frame. Large as well as delicate color print made in 1929, signed in pencil by Louis Icart in the lower right margin and justified "201". Watermark LI at the mill in the lower left margin and wet stamp stating: "Original guaranteed engraving". "Illustrator, perfect colorist of the "Roaring Twenties", Icart magnified an era which he was one of the first to understand that it would go through the image that women had of themselves. Bearer like no other artist of the "rococco" tone of Art Deco, he knew how to be modern and leave us today this inevitable impression of a time like no other ... " Bénézit V, Dictionary of painters, p. 599. Small tear (without lack) in upper margin.
