Nepal, knife called "KHUKURI" with its two small knives "Karda & Chakmak". Knife weapon in the regiments of GURKHAS fighters. Strong blade with 1 cutting edge and its notch allowing the flow of blood (kanda or kaura), bearing grease residue and marking on the heel of the blade with the letters "N K H". Water buffalo horn flare on the khukuri and on the two knives. Length of the blade of the khukuri, 27 cm Thickness of the blade: 1 cm Length of the knives: 11 cm Length of the blade of the knives: 6 cm Leather sheath with brass button. Total length with scabbard: 42.5 cm Length without scabbard: 40 cm Weight with scabbard: 850 g Khukuri weight: only 650 g. Good state of conservation and use, in its juice, see the photos.
