Baroque silver goblet Maker's Mark: ERK for Egidius Rudolph Kindleb, Erfurt (master since 1685, mentioned until 1708, died in 1713) Erfurt around 1700-1708 Marked on the bottom with a double maker's mark and a tremulation line Silver 13 Loth (?), Partly gold-plated, very beautiful original fire gilding on the edge of the lip and inside Engraving: EAW coat of arms under the aristocratic crown with the year 1720 Dimensions: height 6 cm, diameter 7.2 cm, weight 83 g. Condition: very good original condition, a coat of arms with the mark of the city of Erfurt and the mark of the master ERK belongs to the
