These illustrations of yesteryear are surrounded by a bronze garland. The frames are in satin mahogany. This opening is provided with a bronze entry, and equipped with a functional lock supplied with its key. It offers a mahogany interior, consisting of a shelf on cleats. The belt and the crosspiece, adorned with motifs, are underlined by a gadrooned
