it is adorned with a crown and numerous jewels. it is mainly green in color and polychrome with its original gilding.

it is monoxyle only the finely worked wings have been added as well as the tail.

some small gaps in the fingers but not serious. Garuda is a bird creature from Hindu mythology that blends characteristics of an eagle and a human.

He is the vehicle (vahana) of Vishnu and appears on the banner of the god.
