Description

Beautiful oil on wood panel by Jean Georges Pasquet (1851-1936) representing the Atalaye promontory in Biarritz, oil signed lower left and located lower right. JG Pasquet loved the Atlantic coast, offering us landscapes from the Royan region, but also from the Basque Country, in particular views of the bay of Saint Jean de Luz and Biarritz, constituting real testimonies of these sites at the end of the 19th century. JGPasquet gives us a work in bright and contrasting colors, which brings out the wild side of this site. A native of Périgueux, Jean Georges Pasquet was a pupil of Boulanger, Jules Lefèvre, and Benjamin Constant. Thereafter, he became a professor at the school of drawing of Périgueux Classical painter of landscapes, he had integrated into his works the lessons of Impressionism; he had a fairly
