This decor was developed by Pierre Poquet, workshop foreman at the pottery factory in Quimper. Brand: HB QUIMPER °° (period 1950/60) diameter: 38 cm Good condition. No cracks, no hair, no chips, no chips. Sounds very clear on hit. Guaranteed unrestored. Authenticity guaranteed. I note: Photo N°4 shows a shrinkage of enamel during cooking and not a shine. Still too little known, the production of earthenware with cased "Embroidery" decorations and beaded decorations mainly comes from the workshop of Pierre Poquet (1900-1973).
