Crest mask representing a face wearing a labret at the level of the upper lip. This type of mask is called "Lipiko" and was used during initiation ceremonies. He embodies an idealized ancestor. Makonde people, Tanzania or Mozambique Early 20th century Dim: 25 x 15 x 19.5 cm Wood, pigment, fabric. Slight cracks and slight lack Provenance: former collection of a Swiss diplomat.
