Lit: Born in Paris, son of a cabinetmaker, Marie Georges Charles started his education as a sculpture at the School of fine Arts of Paris in 1884 under the supervision of Alexandre Falguière and later Gabriel Jules Thomas. He exhibited regularly at the Salon from 1883 till 1890 and then sporadically until 1903. Among his most characteristic works are "Aquila" (bronze 1892), "Les Nénuphars" (terra cotta bust, 1899) and of course this most famous work "Tahoser",
