Dimensions: Length: 51 cm Length of the bars (wooden part only) 38.8 cm and 28.5 cm Diameter of the bars: 2.8 cm (end piece) Weight: 1,200 kg In its discovery state. All the elements that compose it are entirely original. I decided to leave the patina of time and not to distort it with excessive cleaning but you can, if you wish, restore its original luster. One of the split bars was formerly glued (see photo) but
