The central medallion is embellished with fine engraving, and the signature "C. LE ROI À PARIS" is clearly visible, attesting to its Parisian origin and the quality of its clockmaker.Ornate Bracket: The lower section of the clock is complemented by an equally ornate matching bracket, richly decorated with gilt bronze appliqués and scrollwork, extending the cartel's magnificence.
