scrolling acanthus leaves, all meticulously cast and gilded. A finely sculpted gilt bronze figure, likely representing Apollo or a mythological character, is integrated into the lower part of the dial, depicted playing a lyre and accompanied by an animal (possibly a dog or wolf). A small cherub figure crowning the pediment of the clock adds a playful yet sophisticated touch.

**Sumptuous Dial and Hands:** The dial is elegantly designed with Roman numerals on white enamel cartouches, surrounded by delicate gilt bronze filigree work. The hands are finely crafted, complementing the overall aesthetic of the piece.
