The historic city of Tabriz, the very first capital of the Safavid dynasty, is the 6th most populated city in Iran. Located 600 km west of Tehran, it is the capital of the province of Eastern Azerbaijan, which can also boast of being one of the first local cradles of carpet manufacturing. The quality of Tarbiz rugs has a specific denomination, "Raj", which corresponds to the number of knots in an area of 7 cm. The higher the Raj, the higher the
