Belgian painter, born on March 16, 1844 in Boisfort. Died in Brussels in 1923.

Postimpressionist painter of seascapes and landscapes.

He is part of the group of landscape painters of Termonde.

He started in Brussels in 1870 where he regularly exhibited at the Salons de la Ville. He also participated in the Paris Salons. He obtained two bronze medals at the Universal Exhibitions of 1889 and 1900.

He successfully exhibited in Paris, Munich, Vienna, Chicago and Moscow.

He is considered one of the best marinists. His easy, broad, bold and admirably supple touch imparts a poignant eloquence to his skies and waters.
