Charles X period dressing table in Rio Rosewood veneer with inlaid decorations, lemon tree, foliage, foliage and flowers, framed by two nets. The top has a perimeter made of four concave elements, miter cut, with lemon ridges. This flap is equipped with hinges and held in the open position by a brass compass. A key activates an original hook lock allowing it to be closed. The interior, darkened with a mirror, also offers a compartmentalized space with a candlestick. This small piece of furniture opens on the front with a drawer, with similar marquetry, with lock and key. It also offers a writing area in lemon tree, dressed in dark blue leather, accompanied by its pencil case and inkwell. The set rests on legs cut into lyres, connected by a turned spacer with flanges and macarons in lemon tree. This piece
