The Jensen & Wendel production period (1945-1951) is one of the most sought-after phases in the house's history: in the immediate post-war period, the Jensen Silberschmiede was temporarily operated under a joint management

The Pyramid collection -- designed by Harald Nielsen from 1927, with direct inspiration from the treasures of Tutankhamun's tomb discovered in 1922 -- is one of the most celebrated Art Déco creations of Georg Jensen. The characteristic stepped profile, the sphere and the absolute geometric restraint have earned the Pyramid series a permanent place in museum collections worldwide. Pieces from the collection are held at the Designmuseum Danmark in Copenhagen, MoMA in New York and Koldinghus in Denmark. Harald Nielsen (1892-1977), brother-in-law of founder Georg Jensen, was one of the most prolific and influential designers of the Silberschmiede for several decades.
