Description

Bronze sculpture of a hunting dog , of the breed "Setter" by the sculptor Jules Moigniez (1835-1894) .The Setter is shown standing , in motion , distinguished by its elegant carriage .He is looking towards the horizon for prey , his senses alert .Jules Moigniez demonstrates a fine knowledge of animal behavior .Sculptor's signature "J.MOIGNIEZ" on the naturalistic terrace .Early edition sculpture , second half of the XIXth century .Very good condition and patina.Dimensions : 17 cm x 32.5 cm x 9.5 cmJules Moigniez (1835-1894)Jules Moigniez is a French animal sculptor .He was a student of Paul Comolera (1818 - 1897) , a great sculptor specializing in birds , himself a student of François Rude .J.Moigniez exhibited his first sculpture "Dog Braque stopping a pheasant" at

the age of twenty at the Universal Exhibition of 1855 in Paris .He then exhibited regularly at the Salon , from 1859 to 1892 , where he obtained an honorable mention in the first year .He presented his sculptures again at the Paris Universal Exhibition in 1878.Jules Moigniez enjoyed great success , particularly in England and the United States . Indeed , his works are considered remarkably detailed , with very thorough carving , complemented by elegance in attitudes .Faced with his son's success,his father created a foundry especially for him .
