This shaped piece consists of a kettle, topped with a lid adorned with a pull button in the shape of an open flower and foliage. This rests on a structure cut out on four legs, which includes in its center the heating element provided with a wick. True testimony to an art of living from another era, and goldsmithing know-how, this very beautiful Samovar will skillfully decorate your table.
