Oil on canvas representing Hercules and Omphale, entourage of Sebastiano Mazzoni, Venice at the end of the 17th century This highly prized subject of Greek and Roman mythology has known many variations and interpretations, having inspired Mannerist painting in Italy and France as well as the painting of artists. in Venice, the scene therefore represents Hercules, distaff and spindle in hand, reduced to spinning wool because he is subjugated by the queen of Lydia, Omphale, who has put on her attributes: the lion skin of the Greek hero, whose see here the legs and the club that she is holding in a suggestive way The two characters are surrounded by angels and rich draperies, the power sensuality and the invoice of the painting are typical of Venetian painting of the end XVIIet
