" Italian furniture company Driade was founded in 1968 by designers Enrico Astori, Antonia Astori and Adélaïde Acerbi, on three main principles: project planning, execution and advertising. Enrico is the artistic director, Antonia the designer and architect, and Adélaïde is in charge of branding and communication. Their ultimate goal is to introduce experimentation into mass production.
