Elegant cabinet in cherry wood from the Directoire period. In a policeman's hat, finely mulrated and sculpted, still influenced by Louis XV in some of its decorative elements such as medallion doors or its snail-shaped feet, Louis XVI by the sculpture, but already from the Directoire period by the diamond patterns uprights or on the base of the two frame columns. In excellent condition having undergone only very minimal restorations (winding of the front feet), it has kept key and cremone lock. The photos are not quite enough to illustrate the elegance of this pretty piece of furniture, ideal for a beautiful home. Mayenne or nearby. At the turn of the eighteenth and nineteenth centuries.
