Adrien Simoneton was born in Paris in 1862 to Antoine Simoneton and Emmanuelle Ollive, creators of the Simoneton establishments, a world-renowned company in the textile sector, fire hoses, various filters, etc. Holders of numerous patents and awards have acquired in the various universal exhibitions. Adrien will prefer to choose a life as an artist: draftsman, engraver, cabinetmaker and above all painter. Landscape painter he will paint the bay of Naples, the bay of Saint-Tropez, then at the beginning of the 20th century he will be
