Pair of cruets for oil and vinegar probably made to go in a carcass oil holder (see photo 2, the oil holder is not included) in hard porcelain with polychrome decoration of flower throws, blue and gold threads. marked in blue with intertwined LLs

Under the patronage of Louis XV, the Porcelain Factory of Vincennes then Sèvres became one of the most influential factories in Europe. Sèvres continually produced fashionable new designs which were widely admired and imitated.
